The 2026 Fair Pageant will be held on August 15th at the Logan County Fairgrounds.

- Ages 0-6 will compete at 10am
 - Ages 7 & up will compete at 2pm
 - All talent contestants will compete during the 2pm pageant.
 - Entry fee is \$40 per contestant
- Application deadline is 5pm, August 1st. Each contestant will compete in two categories: Fair Wear and Formal Wear.

Rules and Information:

1. Fair wear and Formal wear will be scored at 50% a piece.
2. Score sheets will NOT be handed out of the pageant.
3. Ages 0-13 do not have to be residents of Logan County.
4. Ages 14+ must be residents of Logan County.
5. Hair and makeup must be kept age appropriate.
6. There will be an intercession between fair wear and formal wear in order to give time for outfit/hair/makeup changes.
7. A scholarship may be awarded to the Miss contestant pending the number of contestants, award availability, and the amount of volunteer hours during their year as Queen. Amount TBD.

Rules and Information:

2. Talent must not be longer than three minutes.
3. Age groups will be determined by the number of contestants following the application deadline.
4. Props are welcome, but there will be a 1-minute maximum set up time.
5. Winners will receive a trophy and the ability to move on to the Arkansas State Talent Show in Little Rock.
